Deadline to apply: Jan 15, 2022

These guidelines are for programs only. Visit our website for capital construction Beneficiary Guidelines. Eligible projects are those that would occur anywhere between 77th St., near Wabasso, and the North Indian River County line, east of I-95.

Youth sports programs will not be considered, as these are being funded by the ShrimpFest.

Organization must submit a letter on its letterhead to *Sebastian Clambake Foundation* that includes the following:

1. Name of the organization and its mission
2. Details of the program for which funding is being requested
3. Explanation of how this program will serve our local community
4. Amount of funding requested. Please keep your request at or under \$1,000.

Supporting documentation may include the following:

1. A list of the members of the organization's Board of Directors
2. The total budget for the program
3. Documentation regarding any organizations that are in partnership with the program
4. Other sources of funding already obtained
5. One or two letters of support from community leaders or others involved in the program
